Ambassador to meet with Councils

The Australian Ambassador to Serbia, North Macedonia and Montenegro, H.E Ms Ruth Stewart, will meet with Councillors and other regional leaders at an event hosted by the Cradle Coast Authority and Tasmanian Leaders next week. This is the third Linking With A Leader event that the two organisations have partnered on.

Ambassador Stewart lived in Burnie previously, and will be talking about a range of economic development matters and learning more about what the region has to offer the rest of the world. The Ambassador will also participate in a roundtable discussion about agritourism, and share insights gleaned from the Global Heads of Mission Meeting that she is attending in Canberra prior to her visit. Ms Stewart was previously Deputy Head of Mission, Australian Embassy, Phnom Penh.

The Cradle Coast Authority has also arranged for the Ambassador to meet with education and business representatives.

"As well as being an Ambassador for Australia, Ms Stewart can be an ambassador for our region. Nobody knows our region like our Councillors, so this is a really great opportunity. We're proud to partner with Tasmanian Leaders on these kinds of events" said CCA CEO, Daryl Connelly.
