CCA WELCOMES LIBERAL PARTY'S COMMITMENT TO PLANNING AND HOUSING

Cradle Coast Authority (CCA) has welcomed the Tasmanian Liberals' commitment of \$150k to support a new regional planning role within CCA. The initiative is one of five regional election priorities identified by CCA and its Member Councils.

The role will assist in the development of the next regional land use strategy and ensure the strategy reflects the region's long term social, economic and environmental needs.
